LOOKING AHEAD

- With a Win at Miami...**
- The **49ers** would break the all-time series tie and improve to 7-6 against the Dolphins, including a 3-3 record on the road.
 - San Francisco** would move to 7-4 against AFC East opponents since 2008.
 - The **Niners** would win their second-consecutive game against Miami for the first time since winning on 11/20/95 (W, 44-20 at Mia.) and 12/16/01 (W, 21-0 at SF).
 - Chip Kelly** would improve to 1-1 as a head coach against Miami.

THE KICK IS UP...AND GOOD

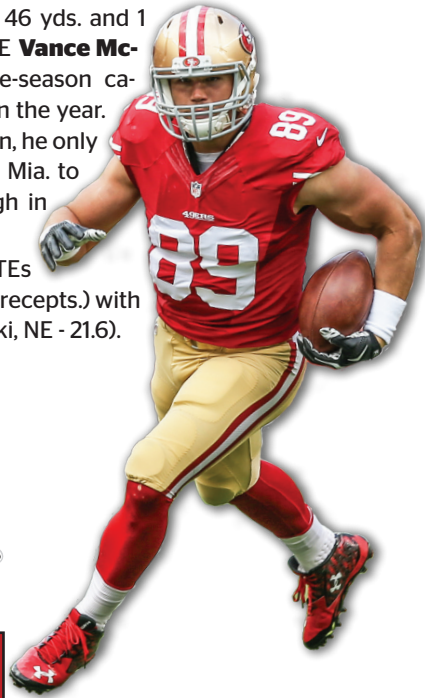
- After making his 400th career FG last week vs. NE (11/20), K **Phil Dawson** has the best FG pct. in NFL history among kickers with 400 career made FGs at 84.7% (400 of 472).
- Dawson** holds the 49ers top two records for most consecutive made FGs with 27 in 2013 and 19 in 2015. He currently holds a streak of 11-consecutive made FGs this season.
- This season, **Dawson** has made 14 of 15 FGAs (93.3%), with his lone miss coming from 53 yds. His 93.3 FG percentage ranks 3rd in the NFL this season among active kickers.

HIGHEST FG PCT. IN 2016 AMONG ACTIVE KICKERS

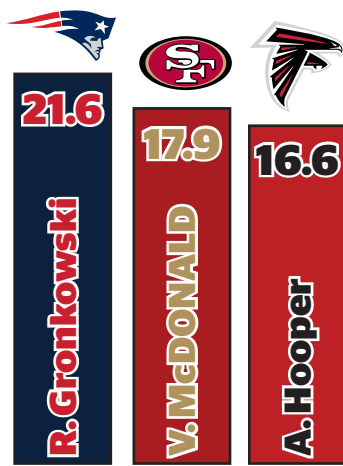


HE'S LOVIN' IT

- After recording 3 recepts. for 46 yds. and 1 TD last week vs. NE (11/20), TE **Vance McDonald** set a personal single-season career-high with 4 TD recepts. on the year. With 322 rec. yds. on the season, he only needs 5 rec. yds. this week at Mia. to set a single-season career-high in rec. yds.
- McDonald** ranks 2nd among TEs in the NFL this season (min. 15 recepts.) with a 17.9 rec. avg. (Rob Gronkowski, NE - 21.6).

- With TD recepts. of 65 and 75 yds. this season, **McDonald** is only the fourth TE since the merger in 1970, and the first since 1997 (Shannon Sharpe, Den.), to register 2 TD recepts. of 65-or-more yds. in the same season.

GOLDEN NUGGETS

- Throughout 14 career regular season starts against AFC opponents, QB **Colin Kaepernick** has thrown for 2,852 yds., 17 TDs and a passer rating of 91.5.
- Kaepernick's** 7.22 rushing avg. on the season leads the NFL among QBs (min. 10 atts.).
- RB **Carlos Hyde** has accumulated career highs in rushes (141), rushing yds. (529) and rushing TDs (6) this season in 8 games played. With 5 additional rushing TDs throughout the remainder of the season, he would break the franchise record for the most rushing TDs in a single season, which currently stands at 10 (6 players).
