LOOKING AHEAD

With a Win vs. Seattle...

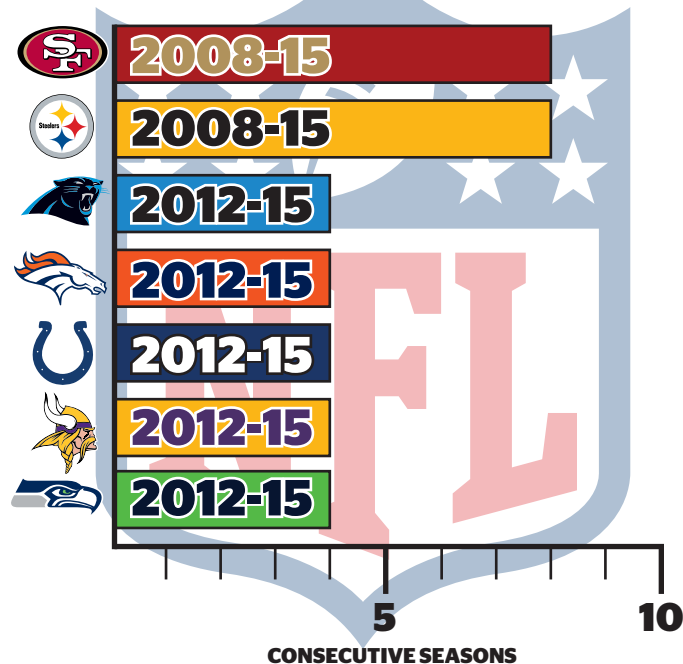
- The **49ers** would improve to 16-21 all-time against the Seahawks, including an 9-8 record at home.
- The **Niners** would split the season series with the Seahawks for the first time since 2013.
- **San Francisco** would win its 10th-straight regular season home finale. The team's current nine-game winning streak in home finales is the longest active streak in the NFL.

- The **49ers** would win their ninth-consecutive regular season finale. The team's eight-game winning streak in season finales is tied for the longest active streak in the NFL (Pit.).

GOLDEN NUGGETS

- After throwing 2 TDs at Atl. (12/18) and 2 TDs at LA (12/24), with 2-or-more TD passes this week vs. Sea., QB **Colin Kaepernick** would throw multiple TDs in three-consecutive games for the first time in his NFL career.
- With 1.0 sack vs. Sea. DL **DeForest Buckner** would move past DE Andre Carter for the 4th-most sacks by a rookie in 49ers franchise history.
- With 1 TD recept. vs. Sea., WR **Jeremy Kerley** would set a new single season career high with his 4th TD recept. He has also set a career high in receipts. this season (58).
- LB **Ahmad Brooks** has registered 6.0 sacks over his last 5 games against Seattle, including 1.0-or-more in each contest.

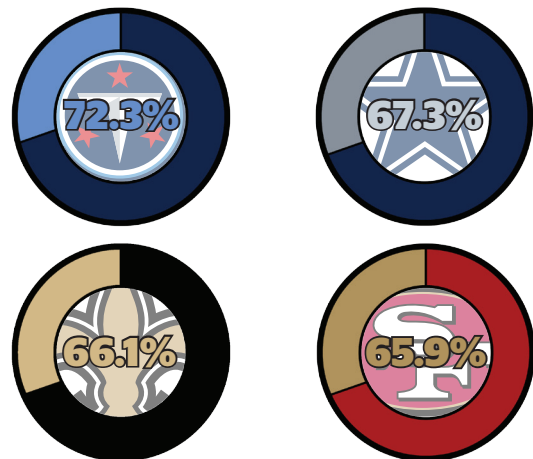

FIND THE END ZONE IN THE RED ZONE

- The **49ers offense** has found the end zone 27 of 41 times (65.9%) when reaching the red zone this season, the 4th-best red zone touchdown efficiency in the NFL.

HIGHEST RED ZONE TD EFFICIENCY, 2016



- **San Francisco's** current 65.9 red zone TD pct. is on pace to be the best registered by the team since 1994 (72.5% - 50 of 69 trips), according to the Elias Sports Bureau.
- The **Niners** have scored TDs on each of their last 7 trips to the red zone (5 passing & 2 rushing).
